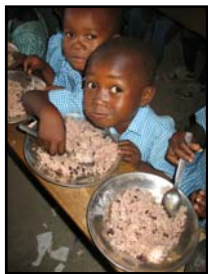
- ❖ Ministry supplies: for VBS, school supplies, etc.
